Emergency Kits are needed at every grade level.

First/Second Grades

1 ream white copy paper
Box of Clorox wipes (Willis, Marsh, Duty, Edmiston)
Watercolor paints
Box of crackers, snacks (Willis, Marsh, Duty)
Dry Erase markers
1" 3-ring binder (Willis, Marsh only)
24 **sharpened** #2 pencils
1 box of crayons (minimum 24 count)
1 pair scissors (Fiskar preferred)
1 8-oz. Elmer's white glue (all except Willis, Marsh)
6 large glue sticks or 10 small
1 Pink Pearl eraser
1 set of 12 Crayola colored pencils (all except Willis, Marsh)
2 spiral notebooks, wide ruled, minimum 70 sheets
1 small pencil school box (approx. 9 x 5)
2 boxes Kleenex
Book bag or backpack
2 gallon-size freezer **bags** (all except Willis, Marsh)
1 box sandwich baggies-ziploc style (all except Willis, Marsh)
1 manual pencil sharpener with shavings case (all except Willis, Marsh)

Third/Fourth Grades

Calculator: simple function, solar
1 large pink eraser

Old sport sock (as dry eraser)

Fifth Grade and 3-4-5 GATE

Backpack
2 boxes Kleenex
Flashdrive (GATE only)
3 spiral notebooks
Simple function calculator (solar preferred)
1 pair scissors
1 3-ring binder (2")
Notebook paper (constant supply)
Erasers-large pink or pencil toppers
2 reams of white copy paper
4 bottles or glue sticks
Dictionary/Thesaurus (pocket-size)
#2 Pencils (constant supply)
Ruler (with U.S. and metric units)
Ink pens (red and blue or black)
Crayons, box of 24 and/or Markers (box of 6)
1 pack 4-6 whiteboard (dry erase) markers (Hinderlie, Quinn, GATE)
1 set 12-count colored pencils (Hinderlie, Quinn)

It is most efficient to send in supplies in small quantities and replace as needed as space is limited in the student's desk.

Optional Items to be shared:

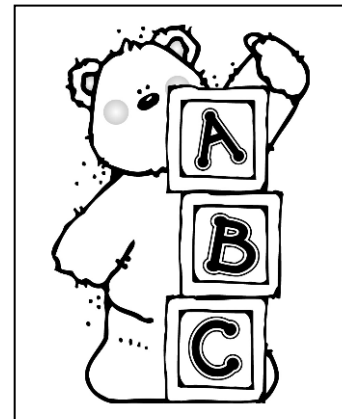
- Large watercolor markers

Extended-Day Kindergarten

Refer to the list below for the necessary school supplies that your child will need to bring to school in September. We share supplies so please **do NOT** label with your child's name.

1. 1 regular sized backpack, labeled with child's name (include 1 extra pair of socks, underwear, and pants for rainy days or emergencies)
2. 1 ream of white paper
3. 2 Johnson & Johnson Foamy Blaster soap
4. 12 glue sticks
5. 1 box of Crayola crayons, 24 count
6. 1 box Crayola brand washable markers (8 count)
7. 1 box of 1-gallon size zip-lock bags
8. Emergency kit (see back of this page to make your own, PTA also sells the kits at the beginning of the year)



9. \$40.00 to cover snacks (2x daily) for the year (may be paid in two payments of \$20.00, in September and January, checks made out to Enterprise PTA.) If you need to make smaller payments, you may send me a note. This is very important to the children. They love their two snacks each day. I have found if I buy the snacks that we can eat healthier foods like apples, carrots, etc. In kindergarten your child doesn't bring their own food or water for snacktime.
