

Instructions & Course Planning Guide

1. Make sure you are fulfilling your graduation requirements (use your credit check/Course History)
2. When you are selecting your classes, also make note of an appropriate alternate choice.
3. Ask yourself: how am I challenging myself to take higher level courses (i.e. X or IB classes)?
4. For your core classes (English, math, science & social studies), be sure to talk to your current teachers about which class you should be taking next.
5. Potential IB Diploma students should plan to meet with Kailey Harem.
6. Potential IB CP (Career Program) students should plan to meet with Jeni McKay.
7. You will indicate if you are interested in Puget Sounds Skills Center or Running Start on the Google Form, but you will still be required to request a **full** TJ schedule. We will send instructions for next steps in March and your course requests will be adjusted accordingly.
