## RULES FOR PARKING ON PUBLIC SREETS

Be a good Neighbor /  
Courtesy reminders:

1. Don't litter
2. Greet people kindly
3. Be respectful of their property (don't walk on their grass or bushes)
4. Keep noise level and music low
5. Don't hang out in your car after parking

- Make sure there are no street signs restricting parking
- Park with your right tires to the curb. Do not park opposing traffic
- Do not double park a vehicle, park on a sidewalk, or block a home's driveway
- Make sure your registration is up-to-date (over 45 days = impound!)
- Do not leave valuables in your car
- Leave 15 feet of space from any fire hydrant
- Leave 5 feet from any intersection
- Do not block any mailboxes
- Park your car and head to school. No loitering
- Reminder: TJ is a closed campus. Students should not be returning to cars until their school day is over
