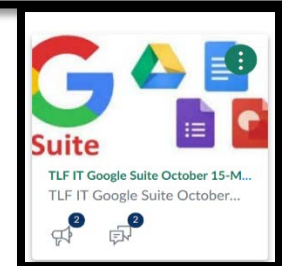
FWPS Sphero Winter Choreography Challenge
