

## Nautilus K-8 Multiple Opportunities Plan



Nautilus students will be given multiple opportunities to demonstrate mastery of the Priority Standards for each class, recognizing that students learn at different rates and times.

Teachers will continue to reteach concepts needed for students to master the Priority Standards.

In order for a student to show mastery of a Priority Standard, the student needs to:

1. Work with the teacher to identify what Priority Standards need to be reassessed and identify what additional practice needs to be done before retaking the assessment.
2. Demonstrate readiness to retake the assessment through proof of additional practice and/or parent communication.
3. Work with the teacher to schedule a time to retake the assessment at a time that will best meet the needs of both the teacher and student (during class, before or after school, or during lunch).
4. In general, retake the assessment within the marking period it was first given (exceptions will be made for extended absences or other exceptional circumstances). In some cases, Priority Standards are assessed repeatedly throughout the school year, allowing for mastery in a different marking period.
