

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

THE PURPOSE OF THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING IS TO SET FORTH THE FOLLOWING AGREEMENT BETWEEN PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEES OF FEDERAL WAY PSE AND THE FEDERAL WAY SCHOOL DISTRICT # 210. THIS UNDERSTANDING IS ENTERED INTO PURSUANT TO THE PARTIES COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT ARTICLE XVIII SECTION 18.3.

The parties agree to the following:

The Camera Technician position is responsible for reviewing video that is requested for student or employee behavior. The district has a need to move this part time position to a full time position to include managing the technical aspects of the video cameras, video storage, and technical repairs on the camera. The current three hour position (37% ) has been covered by a current bus driver in the PSE union reviewing video of their co-workers/peer bus for allegations of misconduct by students and/or staff. The district has a need to be proactive in video review and storage since many times parent complaints do not come in until after the video is no longer available, limiting the District's defense response. The district is requesting the updated job description be moved to a Professional Technical (Prof-Tech) position.

The parties agree to move the Camera Tech position from the PSE bargaining unit to the Professional Technical Association affective upon signing.
