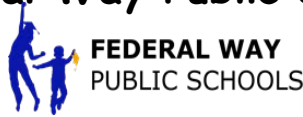




# Traffic Safety Education

## Driver's Ed Registration - 2018/2019

### Federal Way Public Schools



**Registration:** To enroll, Students must be 15 years old on or before the first day of class. To enroll, complete the registration form and visit the Traffic Safety Office or email your registration form to [klowe@fwps.org](mailto:klowe@fwps.org). Class placement will be first-come first-serve basis. Receipt and verification of class, teacher, location and time will be e-mailed upon receipt of registration payment.

**Class:** Registration fee - \$500.00, payable to FWPS. Payment plan option is available. Three (3) payments (\$250.00 at the time of registration, 2nd payment is \$150.00, third payment is \$100.00 payments are due every 30 days). All phases of the Traffic Safety program must be completed prior to any testing taking place. The phases include the classroom portion & behind the wheel (drives). Student will not be able to take the Knowledge test if there is a balance on their account. Payments are due before the last day of class. Payments may be made by Cash, Check, Money Order or VISA/Master Card. Please do not mail registration forms or payments. **LAST DAY TO REGISTER IS THE THURSDAY PRIOR TO CLASSES STARTING.**

**Class Locations:** Todd Beamer - Decatur - Federal Way - Thomas Jefferson

**Class Times:** All classes will meet two (2) days a week Monday & Wednesday or Tuesday & Thursday right after school. When you register, you will receive a confirmation with the class details.

The night class times are 6:00 PM - 8:00 PM on Monday & Wednesday at Thomas Jefferson High School.

#### 2018/2019 Classes: Last day to register is the Thursday prior to classes starting!

Fall Session - September 24th - November 28th

Winter Session - December 10th - February 25th

Spring Session - March 11th - May 16th (New Spring Class Dates)

Summer Session - Information will be available in April 2019

**Classroom Instruction:** Students are required to attend 90% of all classroom sessions. Missing more than two classes can result in the student being dropped from the class & loss of registration fee.

**Driving Instruction:** Student drives will be scheduled by the instructor, plan to be flexible. In addition to the classroom, students usually drive once or twice a week. Each student will receive six lessons for a total of six hours behind-the-wheel. Missing driving lessons may require an additional fee per missed drive. Depending on instructor availability, driving lessons may extend beyond classroom session.

**Driving Permit:** All registered students will receive information about how to obtain their permit when they register for a class.
