DATES AND TIMES AND SCHEDULES:

Q: Will Sunnycrest be closed during the summer?

- Yes, the building will be closed until later this summer. District staff will continue to deep-clean the building. Check your email and visit our website (www.fwps.org/sunnycrest) or Facebook page (www.facebook.com/sunnycrestFWPS) for up-to-date information.

Q: When can I pick up my child's belongings from Sunnycrest?

- All scholars will be able to pick up personal belongings from the school next week, June 15—18. To minimize health risk, there is a schedule. No one will be allowed to enter the building, instead, school staff will bring you and your child their belongings. Staff will be wearing masks and gloves, and following social distancing guidelines. If you have more than one child at Sunnycrest, you may come during any one of their timeslots.

Q. When will I get my child's report card?

- Your child's report card will be available on ParentVUE (grades.fwps.org) on June 19. Physical copies of the report card will be mailed home later this summer.

Q. When does school start in the Fall?

- The first day of school is scheduled for Wednesday, September 2, 2020 for 1st—12th grade. Kindergarteners begin Tuesday, September 8. Follow www.fwps.org for any updates or changes to the school-year calendar.

Q: When school starts again, will my child attend full-time?

- We don't know yet. Direction about reopening will come from the WA Superintendent of Public Instruction and the Washington State Governor's Office. Then, FWPS Superintendent Tammy Campbell will continue working with a group of educators, families and staff to make the safest, most informed decisions for our children. They are also coordinating with other school districts in our area. More information will come soon!






SUMMER LEARNING:

Q. Can my child keep their laptop over the summer?

- Yes, your scholar can keep their district laptop over the summer, unless you are moving out of the Federal Way School District (FWPS). FWPS will let you know when and where to turn it in at the end of the summer.

Q. What learning should my child do over the summer?

- Your child should read! At least 20 minutes a day, in English and/or their home language. Dual Language scholars should also read in Spanish. Online resources are available in the table below. Read! Read! Read!
- Your child can continue logging into their Clever account over the summer to complete myPath reading and math lessons in iReady.

Q. IS FWPS providing online learning this summer?

- Yes!
- The district will be mailing packets and providing online learning activities to help minimize learning loss over the summer. *Set aside 90 minutes a day if your child is in grades K-5.*

- Five-weeks' worth of standards-based activities will be mailed to students the week of July 6, 2020. These are not graded.

FOOD AND OTHER RESOURCES:

Q: Will FWPS' meals program continue over the summer?

- The current weekly Monday food pickup will end on June 15th.
- A NEW weekly Monday food pickup will begin on June 29 (please note there are no meals the week of June 22) and will end on August 10. The nearest site to Sunnycrest will be outside the Appian Way Apartments, 25818 26th Pl S, every Monday from 11:30am – 1:00pm. Visit www.fwps.org/summermeals for other locations around the district.

Q: Where is the nearest food bank?

- The Multi-Service Center operates food banks in Kent and Federal Way. Visit their website at <https://mschelps.org/covid19/> or call 253-838-6810 for their schedule.

Q: What about EBT (food stamps)?

- Due to COVID-19 school closures, families may be eligible to receive food benefit assistance. These food benefits are called Pandemic EBT Emergency School Meals Program or P-EBT.
- Sunnycrest families may be eligible – complete a free and reduced meals application by June 30th to find out at www.fwps.org/lunchapplication.
- If you qualify for free and reduced meals, you can then apply for P-EBT at www.Washingtonconnection.org or by calling 877-501-2233. Available beginning June 28, 2020.

Q: What about rent, utilities, or other resources?

SCHOOL YEAR 2020-2021 QUESTIONS:

Q. When does school start in the Fall?

- The first day of school is scheduled for Wednesday, September 2, 2020 for 1st—12th grade. Kindergarteners begin Tuesday, September 8. Follow www.fwps.org for any updates or changes to the school-year calendar.

Q. Where are the school supplies lists?

- Next school year, FWPS will be working with suppliers to purchase school supplies for all scholars. They will be free to scholars who qualify for free and reduced lunch, and only \$20 for other scholars. The only school supplies you need to purchase for your child are a backpack and appropriate clothing.

Q. Will Sunnycrest have a uniform next year?

- Sunnycrest does not use a school uniform, but we do have a dress code. You can find it on our website at www.fwps.org/sunnycrest.

Q. I forgot to register my child for Kindergarten! Can I still do it?

- Of course! You can register your child online at www.fwps.org/kiosk. You will be asked to upload documents including: address verification documentation, immunization records and age verification documentation.

Q. I would like my Kindergartener to be in the Dual Language program. What do I do?

- If you have not done so, please fill out the Dual Language Program application here: <https://forms.gle/PobC5A3B1esQQ2HE9>. If you filled out the paper version earlier this Spring, we will be contacting you soon.

Q. My child attended Sunnycrest this year. Do I need to register them for next year?

- No. They are already enrolled for next year. You will need to verify their address, phone number, and emergency contacts starting in August at www.fwps.org/verifyonline.

Q. Who will be my child's teacher next year?

- You received an email from Principal Kelly Maloney on Friday, June 5, with your child's homeroom teacher information for next fall. (This does not include incoming Kindergarteners.) If you are still unsure, please contact us mid-August when the school office re-opens and we can give you that information.
