

Decatur High School 2022-2023 Homecoming Decatur Student Contract

We are excited to have you join us for our homecoming dance. We are working to make the evening as enjoyable as possible. To do this, we need to ensure that all scholars agree and then follow the guidelines for the event.

Important Information:

1. No ticket(s) will be issued to any Decatur Scholar without this agreement form completed in its entirety by both the scholar and their parent/guardian. **You must have your ticket that was issued to you to get in the door.**
2. Tickets will not be issued after October 7th at the end of your students' lunch and will not be available at the event.
3. You must resolve your fines before you can secure your ticket. Please see Mrs. Pierce if you have any questions.
4. If there is a scholar that has been participating in inappropriate behavior prior to the dance they may be banned from the event.
5. Chaperones will be supervising the scholars and their guests.
6. All Decatur HS students must turn in this contract to be issued a ticket.

Requirements and expectations during Decatur High School's Homecoming:

- All Decatur High School and Federal Way Public School rules and regulations apply as this is a school sponsored event. Scholars and their guests that choose to not follow the guidelines as described on this agreement will be asked to leave and will not be allowed back in.
- Decatur scholars bringing a pre-approved non-student guest must arrive and depart with their guest.
- Drugs, alcohol, weapons, tobacco in any form, and any other illegal and or dangerous contraband are not permitted at the premises, in vehicles (including limousines), or at the venue.
- Scholars suspected of being under the influence of drugs, tobacco, or alcohol or in possession of tobacco, drugs, alcohol, or weapons will be subject to the applicable policies and procedures of the school district including school discipline and restriction from future school functions and local law enforcement charges may be applicable.
- All dance attendees will be subject to a light search prior to entry for safety. Scholars who leave the dance before it ends will not be allowed to reenter.
- Scholars attending the dance will be closely monitored by school staff and the local law enforcement members.
- Scholars must stay in the designated area of the venue.
- If any scholar is involved in the vandalism of any part of the venue they will be asked to leave and will receive school discipline, be referred to law enforcement and be held monetarily responsible for the damages.
- No backpacks or large bags will be permitted into the venue.
- Scholars are not permitted to bring food, drinks, other liquids, and/or prescription/non-prescription medicine. Scholars requiring medication of any kind must make arrangements with an administrator prior to October 7.
- Inappropriate, sexually explicit dancing is prohibited. Scholars who engage in inappropriate dancing will immediately be removed from the dance floor. No warnings will be given.

Scholars who violate any of the above rules/expectations or other rules contained in the FWPS scholar handbook may face disciplinary consequences including removal from the dance and/or disciplinary action by the school and/or law enforcement.

I understand and agree to the conditions of receiving a ticket and attending the DHS Homecoming Dance. I will abide by the above expectations for behavior and I understand the consequences for failure to comply.
