Dear Mirror Lake Parents and Families,

As you know, construction on the new Mirror Lake Elementary is underway, and we're excited for what the new building will offer our staff and scholars!

In December 2019, we shared Mirror Lake Elementary would need to be relocated during the fall of the 2020-21 school year, in order for the construction team to finish their work on our brand-new building. The purpose of this letter is to provide an update on this temporary relocation of Mirror Lake Elementary school.

Many options were explored for relocating Mirror Lake Elementary school during the fall of the 2020-21 school year, such as a portable village and relocating individual grade levels to classrooms throughout the district.

We also know the temporary campus currently housing Lake Grove and Wildwood staff and students will have space available once these schools move out during the winter of the 2020-21 school year. This temporary location is currently providing two schools a safe and appropriate temporary home, and we know it can do the same for Mirror Lake Elementary.

This solution allows the students and staff to stay in the current location until December 2020. During winter break of the 2020-21 school year, Mirror Lake Elementary School will move into the temporary campus, located at 3600 S. 344th Way, Federal Way, WA 98003. When Mirror Lake students return from winter break in January 2021, they will begin their time at the temporary campus.

We are excited to have this opportunity for a temporary campus that we know is already equipped to serve our elementary scholars.

While we are located in the temporary campus, the construction team will finish work on the new building, demolish the old building and complete site work. We will begin the 2021-22 school year in the brand-new Mirror Lake Elementary School building.

We know the benefits of a new school for Mirror Lake will outweigh the challenges of construction, and our focus will always be ensuring a safe environment for our scholars to learn.
